Weekly Professional Dress Day, every Wednesday

Business Attire:

Meriwether County believes in preparing students for the workforce, so practicing how to dress for an interview or for the job of your career choice is very important.

I would like to see students wearing professional business attire **every Wednesday** if they are in healthcare classes. Not suits, just nice, clean clothes. **They may choose to wear scrub sets if desired.** Scrubs may be any color or pattern for HC1 and HC2 classes. Royal blue will be required for HC3 (CNA) class.

Females: BUSINESS ATTIRE - Dress slacks/dress skirts, blouse, and dress shoes (closed toed, heels no higher than 1 inch), skirt or pants suit (should not be tight, skirt should be at 2 inches above the knee or longer).

Male: BUSINESS ATTIRE - Khaki pants/dress slacks (any color), polo style or oxford shirts (TUCKED IN). Dress shoes and matching belts, no sneakers/jeans/t-shirts.

If they are in Patient Care Fundamentals (HC3- CNA) they may wear professional dress as described above or nursing scrubs (Royal Blue) as their professional dress on Wednesdays. They will need to have at least 2 sets of royal blue scrubs for their clinical site rotations near the end of the program. Wait to buy these closer to the dates of the clinical site training.

Required Supplies (Please make sure students come to school prepared)
